Application Procedures and Fees

Applicants must complete the application procedures at the office of Cemeteries and Crematoria Section of FEHD in Hung Hom or Happy Valley, either in person or through an authorized agent, bringing with them the "Permit To Take Away Cremated Ashes". Application may also be made by post or fax.

Upon completion of application procedures, the applicant may arrange to scatter the cremated ashes of the deceased in the Garden of Remembrance free of charge.

On payment of a prescribed fee, the applicant may also mount a commemorative plaque on the wall of the Garden of Remembrance to commemorate the deceased.
