申請手續

- 申請人可親自或委託授權人提出申請，把填妥的申請表格連同「領取骨灰許可證」正本親身遞交往上述辦事處。
- 申請人亦可傳真或郵寄申請表格往上述辦事處，或於網上填寫電子表格及遞交申請，食物環境衛生署在接獲表格後將聯絡申請人及安排申請人遞交「領取骨灰許可證」正本。

One may choose to return to nature by having his/her cremated ashes scattered in the Garden of Remembrance.

Members of the public can perform memorial rituals and scatter the cremated ashes of their loved ones at the Gardens of Remembrance themselves or with the help of dedicated staff of the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department. This service is free of charge. They can also mount commemorative plaques at the Gardens of Remembrance in fond memory of the deceased after paying the required administration fee.

Application Procedures

- Applicants may apply in person or through an authorised person at the above Office, together with the completed application form and the original copy of the "Permit to Take Away Cremated Ashes".
- The applicant may also choose to send the application form to the above Office by fax or by post, or to fill in the e-form and submit the application online. Upon receipt of the form, the Department will contact the applicant to arrange for submission of the original copy of the "Permit to Take Away Cremated Ashes" in person.
