Complete the registration in relevant FEHD webpage and such registration is confirmed to be valid ➤ Must ensure the ventilating system is properly maintained such that the outside air supply consistently fulfils the approval requirements ➤ Must properly switch on the ventilation system when the premises is opened for business ➤ Proper operate, maintain and repair the air purifiers in accordance with the manufacturer's manual (including the timely replacement of air filters) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Must display notices/posters at the premises entrance (Annex 1) ➤ Update "QR Code Verification Scanner" mobile app to the most updated version ➤ Register upon first activation of scanner app on the device ➤ Ensure that the devices are connected to the Internet at all times when the premises is open for business to facilitate the use of the latest version of the QR Code Verification Scanner mobile app for compliance with the relevant requirements

Note 1:

Two PCR tests in every seven days (on two separate non-consecutive days), and an RAT negative results on the same day before entering the premises for performance or rehearsal.
