Special Arrangement on Loading/Unloading of Goods For 2026 Victoria Park Lunar New Year Fair

Successful bidders for Lunar New Year Fair stalls at Victoria Park will be issued with a temporary parking permit for loading/unloading of goods (not applicable to taxis, motorcycles and container trucks or goods vehicles with length of forty-foot or above). Permit holders and/or their authorised drivers will be allowed to drive into the fair site and park their vehicles in front of their stalls for loading and unloading during the following periods:

As in previous years, part of the parking spaces at the Hing Fat Street Public Carpark on the periphery of Victoria Park will be designated for loading/unloading area of the Lunar New Year Fair in the daytime. Successful bidders requiring daytime loading/unloading should submit an application to the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD) for the arrangement of appropriate timeslots.
