Question:

An audit report found that there was an upward trend in the vacancy rate of public markets. Regarding the stall vacancies in markets, please advise this Committee of the following:

- 1. Please set out in tabular form the number of vacant market stalls in the past 3 years, with a breakdown by district.
- 2. What overhaul or redevelopment projects have been taken forward since the implementation of the Market Modernisation Programme (MMP)?
- 3. What were the expenditure and staff establishment involved in the MMP in the past 3 years?
- 4. How does the Government evaluate the effectiveness of the pilot scheme on stall enhancement and stall concessions in addressing the issue of stall vacancies in markets?

Reply:

- 1. The information sought is in Annex.
- 2. to 4. The Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD) is taking forward the Market Modernisation Programme (MMP) to implement projects of various scales at suitable venues, including overhaul or redevelopment, stall enhancement, as well as minor refurbishment or improvement works.

Regarding overhaul or redevelopment projects, Aberdeen Market and Lai Wan Market officially re-opened in May 2023 and March 2024 respectively after overhaul works. The project costs are about \$254 million and \$46.77 million respectively. FEHD will continue to take forward the overhaul or redevelopment projects in Ngau Tau Kok Market and Kowloon City Market.

As for stall enhancement, the first project is carried out in Queen Street Cooked Food Market (CFM) with a cost of about \$9.5 million. The CFM resumed full operation in September 2024. At present, the daily average patronage of the CFM is about 1 600, an increase of about 20% from that before the works. Stall tenants indicated that the enhancement works have improved the operating environment.

Many members of the public have also expressed that the enhanced CFM offers a contemporary feel and a clean and comfortable dining environment. As at 31 December 2024, the occupancy rate of Queen Street CFM is 100%. In view of the effectiveness of the stall enhancement project in Queen Street CFM and the positive feedbacks from stall tenants and the public, FEHD will continue to identify other suitable venues for stall enhancement works.

With regard to minor refurbishment or improvement works, FEHD has carried out the relevant works in 16 markets. As at 31 January 2025, the works in 15 markets have been completed, while those in the remaining Nam Long Shan Road CFM are expected to be completed in 2025. The project estimates for taking forward the 16 afore-mentioned minor refurbishment or improvement works are about \$86.19 million in total.

FEHD has restored the past arrangement of putting up long-standing vacant stalls that could not be let out in public markets for open auction at reduced upset prices since May 2024, so as to increase the occupancy rate and put long-standing vacant market stalls to better use. Under this arrangement, the upset prices for the stalls in an open auction will be initially set at 80% of the open market rent if the stalls have been vacant for over 6 months, and at 60% if the vacant period is over 8 months. From May 2024 to 31 December 2024, a total of 60 stalls have been successfully let out under this scheme, showing that the afore-mentioned arrangement facilitates the letting out of more stalls. In addition, FEHD implemented a trial arrangement of letting out public market stalls on a first-come, first-served basis from October to December 2024. Stalls which have not been let out in open auctions were made available for renting by members of the public at their upset prices on a first-come, first-served basis.

The MMP is mainly implemented by FEHD with the assistance of the Architectural Services Department (ArchSD). The relevant staff establishments and recurrent expenditures are included in the Estimates of Expenditure of both departments under Head 49 and Head 25. As the Market Development Division (MDD) under FEHD which is responsible for the MMP is also responsible for other duties relating to public market development (e.g. new public market development projects, enhancements to market management and market consolidation/closure, etc.), and the relevant team of ArchSD is also responsible for the works projects of new public markets apart from those under the MMP, we do not keep a separate breakdown of the manpower and expenditure involved in the MMP.

The expenditure and staff establishment of the MDD under FEHD and the relevant team of ArchSD in the past 3 years are as follows:
