Question:

The Government announced in the 2022 Policy Address that fully-enclosed refuse collection facilities with new design (including solar-powered mobile refuse compactors (SMRCs), solar-powered compacting refuse bins (SCRBs) and solar-powered/foot-pedal type aluminium refuse collection points) will be put in place at some 500 priority rural locations. In this connection, please advise this Committee of:

- 1. the numbers of SMRCs, SCRBs and solar-powered/foot-pedal type aluminium RCPs in each district;
- 2. the expenditures involved in providing SMRCs, SCRBs and solar-powered/foot-pedal type aluminium RCPs at rural locations in each of the past 3 years; and
- 3. the additional numbers of SMRCs, SCRBs and solar-powered/foot-pedal type aluminium RCPs to be provided at rural locations this year, the expenditures involved and their locations.

Reply:

- 1. The Food and Environmental Hygiene Department has provided fully-enclosed refuse collection facilities with new design at 319 locations in various districts, including 19 SMRCs, 32 SCRBs and 287 solar-powered/foot-pedal type aluminium refuse collection points (RCPs).
- 2. The expenditures for providing fully-enclosed refuse collection facilities with new design in the past 3 years are as follows:

| Year | Expenditure |
|---------|----------------|
| 2022-23 | \$22.5 million |
| 2023-24 | \$22.0 million |
| 2024-25 | \$19.5 million |

3. The Department will continue to identify more suitable rural locations and plans to provide 180 fully-enclosed refuse collection facilities with new design at some 170 locations in 2025-26. Information on their locations is as follows:

In 2025-26, the estimated costs for providing SCRBs and RCPs are about \$11.0 million and \$12.9 million respectively, while the operation cost for providing SMRCs is about \$6.2 million.
