STARTING



Clear sand traps regularly to avoid accumulation of refuse and water

Keep the drains and surface channels free flow

Do not fill up keyholes on manhole covers with sand

Let water on undulating canvas/plastic sheets to evaporate naturally

Apply pesticide properly to kill mosquito

To keep water on potted plant saucers

Use undrilled tyres for anti-bumping in carpark

Dispose containers in refuse bin with cover

Apply odour-producing cosmetics such as perfume/body lotion during outdoor activities

Leave the defective ground surfaces unattended

Inspect the premises at least once a week for elimination of stagnant water
