Food Related Dry Goods

The sales of the following items are permitted: -

- (a) Biscuit, bread and bakery products;
- (b) Cigarettes;
- (c) Dried grocery products, e.g. spices, seasoning, nuts, rice, etc.;
- (d) Dried and preserved foods;
- (e) Eggs;
- (f) Prepacked food and drinks, including canned food;
- (g) Sweets and confectionery etc; and
- (h) Vermicelli and noodles.

Non-Food Related Dry Goods

The sales of the following items are permitted: -

- (a) Blinds;
- (b) Blankets and cotton quilts;
- (c) Bamboo wares and baskets;
- (d) Books and stationery;
- (e) Clothing, cloth/lace/silk;
- (f) Curios;
- (g) Cassettes and video tapes;
- (h) * Chinese herbs and medicines;
- (i) Electric appliances and electronic parts;
- (j) Fishing equipment and accessories;
- (k) Films and photos;
- (l) Gift items, souvenirs and ornaments;
- (m) Haberdashery, footwear and umbrella;
- (n) Household wares;
- (o) Jade, jewellery and watches;
- (p) Joss sticks and papers, shrines and worshipping tables;
- (q) Kitchen utensils;
- (r) Lighters;
- (s) Locks;
- (t) Mahjong sets;
- (u) Nylon/canvas bags/sacks, rope and string;
- (v) Paintings
- (w) Perfumes and cosmetics
- (x) Spectacles;
- (y) Toys; and
- (z) Wallets, handbags and leather goods.

(Note: Any of the above items may be deleted in certain markets if necessary)

* Regarding the definition of 'Chinese herbs and medicines', the Department will draw reference to Schedules I and 2 of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

Food Related Wet Goods

The sale of the following is permitted –

- (a) Vegetables;
- (b) Bean curd;
- (c) Bean sprout; and
- (d) Raw vegetarian food in wet state.
