

**Sin Tin Toa Home For The Aged Columbarium B**  
**[Covering only niches already sold before 30 June 2017]’s**  
**Temporary Suspension of Liability (TSOL) Application**

**“Approval-in-principle for TSOL Application”**

Based on the documents submitted by the applicant so far, the Private Columbaria Licensing Board (the PCLB) is of the view that the above application for TSOL is basically in compliance with the application requirements for TSOL except for the requirements concerning the ash interment quantity and that the vetting of the niche information and ash interment capacity is still underway, and also, the verification on the owner’s consent for the premises to be used as a columbarium is subject to the completed handling of the application for the appointment of manager(s) of the concerned land owner. The PCLB issued the notification to the applicant on 27 October 2022, informing the applicant that the TSOL application of the above private columbarium has been approved in principle with a validity period of 3 years from 27 October 2022 to 26 October 2025. During this validity period, the applicant should take all necessary steps with reasonable expedition according to the action plan with timetable as submitted to and accepted by the PCLB for compliance with the relevant application requirements of TSOL to achieve compliance with the requirements for the Licence application submitted together with the TSOL application. The above application for TSOL has not been determined by the PCLB

Please note that the “Approval-in-principle for TSOL Application” does not mean that the application for a Licence in respect of the columbarium concerned will be approved eventually. If the applicant fails to comply with all the requirements in respect of the Licence application submitted together with the TSOL application and fails to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that the applicant has taken all the above-mentioned necessary steps with reasonable expedition by the expiry of the validity period of the “Approval-in-principle for TSOL Application”, the PCLB will not extend the validity period of the “Approval-in-principle for TSOL Application” and may refuse the whole set of applications. Under such circumstances, the columbarium concerned will have to cease operation and dispose of the ashes interred in the columbarium in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Private Columbaria Ordinance.

If the applicant has complied with all the requirements in respect of the application for a Licence submitted together with the TSOL application during the validity period of the “Approval-in-principle for TSOL Application”, the PCLB will consider holding an open meeting to examine the relevant application with a view to determining the application for Licence directly.
