## Refusal Reason in respect of Eternal Repose's Licence Application (Applicant: Eternal Repose Company Limited) (Covering only niches unsold as at 30 June 2017)

- (i) This Licence application does not comply with the land-related requirements under Section 18(1)(a)(i) of the Private Columbaria Ordinance (PCO) as the applicant fails to submit documents to prove to the satisfaction of the Private Columbaria Licensing Board (PCLB) that this Licence application complies with the requirements under the aforesaid section of the PCO;
- (ii) this Licence application does not comply with the planning-related requirements under Section 18(1)(a)(ii) of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit documents to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that this Licence application complies with the requirements under the aforesaid section of the PCO;
- (iii) this Licence application does not comply with the building-related requirements under Sections 18(1)(a)(iii) and 19(2) of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit documents to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that this Licence application complies with the requirements under the aforesaid sections of the PCO:
- (iv) this Licence application does not comply with the requirement under Sections 18(1)(b) of the PCO as the applicant fails to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that the applicant holds the columbarium premises directly from the Government under a lease;
- (v) this Licence application does not comply with the requirements under Sections 18(2) and 23(1)(b)(i) of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit a management plan covering the matters prescribed under Section 97 of the PCO;
- (vi) this Licence application does not comply with the requirements under Sections 22 and 23(1) of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit documents proving compliance with fire safety, electrical and mechanical safety and environmental protection requirements in accordance with the specified requirements of the PCLB;
- (vii) this Licence application does not comply with the requirements under Sections 23(1) and 25 of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit the

proposed plans; and

(viii) this Licence application does not comply with the requirement under Section 23(2) of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit documents to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that the owner of the columbarium premises has, or all the joint owners or co-owners of the columbarium premises have, given authorization or consent for the premises to be used as a columbarium.
