

Pun Chun Yuen (Ti Tsang Temple, Koon Yum Temple and 思親堂)’s

Licence Application

“Approval-in-principle for Licence Application”

Based on the documents submitted by the applicant so far, the Private Columbaria Licensing Board (the Licensing Board) is of the view that this application for licence is basically in compliance with the application requirements for licence except for the land-related requirements.

The Licensing Board has decided to give an approval-in-principle for the above licence application for a validity period until 13 May 2027. The applicant has to make efforts to comply with the land-related requirements within the validity period and then notify the Licensing Board in writing.

If the applicant has complied with the above requirements, after Private Columbaria Affairs Office (PCAO) has received a written notification from the District Lands Office, Tai Po confirming its approval of the application for land regularisation, PCAO will report the same to the Licensing Board and submit the licence application to the Licensing Board for determination.

If the applicant has not complied with the above requirements and notified the Licensing Board in writing of its compliance with those requirements within the validity period of this “approval-in-principle for licence application”, the Licensing Board will re-examine this licence application.
