Refusal Reason in respect of Nam Tin Chuk Temple's Temporary Suspension of Liability Application

- (i) This Temporary Suspension of Liability (TSOL) application does not comply with the requirements under Section 21(2)(a) of the Private Columbaria Ordinance (PCO) as the applicant fails to prove to the satisfaction of the Private Columbaria Licensing Board (PCLB) that this TSOL application complies with the following requirements (i) that the ash interment layout is limited in extent to that as at the cut-off time; and (ii) that the extent of occupation of land as is necessary for, or ancillary to, the operation of the columbarium is limited to that as was necessary for, or ancillary to, its operation as at the cut-off time;
- (ii) this TSOL application does not comply with the requirement under Section 21(3) of the PCO as the applicant fails to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that the columbarium has been certified, by a qualified professional, as not posing any obvious or imminent danger in terms of building safety and fire safety;
- (iii) this TSOL application does not comply with the requirements under Sections 22 and 23(1) of the PCO as the documents submitted by applicant are not sufficient for proving compliance with fire safety requirements;
- (iv) this TSOL application does not comply with the requirements under Sections 23(1) and 25 of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit the proposed plans required under the aforesaid sections of the PCO and in accordance with the requirement specified in the PCLB's "Application Guide for Private Columbarium Licence and Other Specified Instruments"; and
- (v) this TSOL application does not comply with the requirement under Section 23(1) of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit all Statement of Particulars of Applicant and Related Persons and the TSOL application summary in accordance with the specified requirement of the PCLB.
