

Refusal Reason in respect of Lee Hing Kee's Exemption Application

- (1) This Exemption Application does not comply with the building-related requirements under Schedule 2 to the Private Columbaria Ordinance (PCO). Thus, it also does not comply with Section 20(1)(g) of the PCO;
- (2) This Exemption Application does not comply with the requirement under Section 20(1)(e) of the PCO i.e. the applicant has to prove to the satisfaction of the Private Columbaria Licensing Board (PCLB) that no interment right in respect of the columbarium has been sold since the cut-off-time (i.e. 8 a.m. on 18 June 2014). The applicant fails to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that the arrangement of keeping certain ashes in the columbarium after the cut-off time is not within the meaning of "sale of interment right" as defined under Section 3 of the PCO; and
- (3) This Exemption Application does not comply with the requirement under Section 20(1)(a) and (b) of the PCO as the applicant fails to submit documents to prove to the satisfaction of the PCLB that this exemption application complies with the requirements under Sections 20(1)(a) and (b) of the PCO.
