Refusal Reason in respect of Prime Florist's Temporary Suspension of Liability Application

Temporary Suspension of Liability application in respect of a pre-cut-off columbarium

(i) This Temporary Suspension of Liability (TSOL) application does not comply with the requirements under Section 23(1) of the Private Columbaria Ordinance (PCO) as the applicant fails to submit an action plan with a timetable, that complies with the requirements specified by the Private Columbaria Licensing Board (PCLB), to set out the necessary steps to be taken to achieve compliance, in a timely manner, with the requirements of the licence application submitted together with the above TSOL application. The Town Planning Board (TPB) has decided not to agree to the planning application in respect of the premises of **Prime Florist** on 18 September 2020. The applicant has not re-submitted a planning application to the TPB in accordance with the action plans that he has submitted to the PCLB.
