## Private Columbaria Ordinance (PCO)

### **Private columbarium – Restrictions on the exemption**

# **NEWLY SELLING / NEWLY LETTING OUT ANY INTERMENT RIGHT IN RESPECT OF THIS COLUMBARIUM IS AN OFFENCE UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE PCO**

- (a) No newly selling / newly letting out of ash interment rights since 30 June 2017 is allowed;
- (b) For the unfilled or partially filled niches in respect of which interment rights were sold before 30 June 2017, the named dedicated person can only be changed to his/her relative (in accordance with the definition of “relative” under section 6(2) of Schedule 5 to the Private Columbaria Ordinance);
- (c) For niches with ashes interred, re-interment of ashes is not allowed if any interred ashes are removed subsequently (e.g. claimed back by descendants);
- (d) After ashes have been interred in the niches referred to in item (b) above, the restriction set out in item (c) above will apply to these niches; and
- (e) The imposition of additional fees or charges beyond the amounts specified in the agreements for the sale of interment rights of the niches is not permitted.
