

Commencement of Ash Disposal Notice
Private Columbaria Ordinance (the “Ordinance”)(Cap.630)

By an order of the Court dated 27 November 2017, Mr. Yuen Tsz Chun, Frank and Mr Kennic Lai Hang Lui, both of KLC Corporate Advisory and Recovery Limited (KLC), were appointed as the provisional liquidators of Ting Wai Monastery Limited (the Company) with power to take possession of the captioned private columbarium (the Columbarium). The provisional liquidators have taken possession of the Columbarium and have, in accordance with section 75(4) of the Ordinance, invited the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene (the Director) on 29.12.2017 to carry out the disposal of ashes at the Columbarium.

Upon the invitation of the provisional liquidators, the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (“FEHD”) hereby give notice that it will, pursuant to the power conferred by section 76(1) of the Ordinance, carry out any steps that the Director considers necessary for the disposal of ashes interred in the Columbarium, including but not limited to, the following:

- (1) Handling the ashes interred in Columbarium with reference to the section 7(2) of Schedule 5 to the Ordinance;
- (2) Arrange for the return of ashes during a period (the Ashes Claim Period) of 12 months specified below—

The date on which the Ashes Claim Period begins: 5.3.2018

The date on which the Ashes Claim Period ends: 4.3.2019

- (3) Handling claims for the return of ashes and any related item(s) with reference to sections 9 and 10 of Schedule 5 to the Ordinance;
- (4) Disposing of the ashes in respect of which no claims have been received and which have not been returned to an eligible claimant after the expiry of the Ashes Claim Period in a manner that the Director thinks fit.

If all the ashes / related items have been returned to the successful eligible claimants before the expiry of the Ashes Claim Period, the date of returning the last set of ashes/related item to the claimant will be regarded as the end date of the Ashes Claim Period.

Please note that the carrying out of the above disposal of ashes does not affect any person's right to compensation under an agreement for the purchase of an interment right in respect of the Columbarium.
