Mrs. Pound Application for New Issue of Liquor Licence	<p>Agreed to issue a 6-month liquor licence with the imposition of the following additional licensing conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) All doors and windows of the premises shall be kept closed between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day;(b) No liquor shall be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises between 10:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day;(c) No consumption of liquor on the premises shall be allowed between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day;(d) No speaker shall be switched on and no music shall be played on the premises between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day; and(e) The licensee shall ensure that liquor sold or supplied is to be consumed on the premises only. <p>(Since the premises are currently issued with a Provisional General Restaurant Licence (PGRL), in accordance with the existing policy, the Board will first issue a liquor licence with an expiry date being the same as the PGRL. Subject to further issue of a valid restaurant licence in respect of the premises, the Board will issue a liquor licence for the remaining approved period.)</p>

Agreed to issue a 12-month liquor licence with the imposition of the following additional licensing conditions:

- (a) No liquor shall be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises between 10:30 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day;
- (b) No consumption of liquor on the premises shall be allowed between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day;
- (c) No sound amplification device shall be switched on and no music shall be played on the premises between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day;
- (d) All doors and windows of the premises shall be kept closed between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day;
- (e) All liquor sold or supplied is to be consumed in the indoor part of the premises only; and
- (f) No person shall be allowed to stay at the outside seating area of the premises between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following day.

(Since the premises are currently issued with a Provisional General Restaurant Licence (PGRL), in accordance with the existing policy, the Board will first issue a liquor licence with an expiry date being the same as the PGRL. Subject to further issue of a valid restaurant licence in respect of the premises, the Board will issue a liquor licence for the remaining approved period.)

<p>HOME BAR AND RESTAURANT 新酒牌申請</p>	<p>同意簽發為期 12 個月的酒牌，並附加下列持牌條件：</p> <p>(a) 晚上 11 時至翌日上午 9 時，處所的所有門窗必須保持關閉；</p> <p>(b) 凌晨 3 時至上午 9 時，不得在處所內飲用酒類飲品；</p> <p>(c) 在任何時候，不得在處所的閣樓售賣、供應或飲用酒類飲品；及</p> <p>(d) 晚上 11 時至翌日上午 9 時，任何人不得在處所閣樓的平台逗留。</p>
